Ben Miller / Ecclesiastes and Living Well

Ben Miller grew up in the Finger Lakes region of New York. In 1999, he received his J.D. from Oak Brook College of Law and was then admitted to the California bar. Thereafter, he attended Greenville Presbyterian Theological Seminary. He served as associate pastor of Franklin Square OPC New York for six years. In 2011, he became the pastor of Trinity Church in Syosset, New York, where he still serves. He and his wife Sarah have four children.

Dr. Roger Schultz is Professor of History at Liberty University and specializes in American Religious History. Since 2006, he also serves as the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences and Dean of the Honors College. He has a Ph.D. in History from the University of Arkansas and an M.A. in Church History from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School. Dr. Brian Thomas joined the Institute for Creation Research in 2008 as a science writer and editor, contributing news and magazine articles, speaking on creation issues, and researching original tissue fossils. Austin State University and a Ph.D. in paleobiochemistry in 2019 from the University of Liverpool.

ADMISSION POLICY

BWSC accepts students of any denomination, race, and national origin. To be eligible to attend, the student must be between rising 10th grade through college age (10th graders must be 15 years old by 10/1/2025). Attendees should come desiring to learn, enjoy Christian fellowship, and joyfully submit to all conference rules and leadership.

ARRIVAL / DEPARTURE

Students are responsible for their own travel plans. BWSC will assist with transport from the Tri-Cities Regional Airport (TRI), if possible. We request that you arrange a flight that arrives no later than 10 p.m., and not on Sunday. Those needing a Saturday stay over for better flight rates may request lodging in homes of church members. Please let us know as soon as possible so that we can make housing arrangements. Conference begins Monday, June 2nd, with the evening meal and concludes Saturday, June 7th, with breakfast. Students may register and check into their rooms from 2 p.m. to 4:45 pm on Monday.

COST AND REGISTRATION

Conference costs, including room, board, and tuition, are \$375 for lodging students, \$285 for day students, and \$275 for counselors. Those registering early and paying the balance due by April 21st will receive a \$50 discount. In addition, there is a family discount to assist families sending 3 or more people to the conference. The first two attendees are at regular cost; the third and subsequent attendees are discounted \$50 each. Payment in full is due by May 5th to avoid a \$25 late fee. Registration forms are on our website **www.bwsctn.org** for printing and must be completed and returned before the conference begins. Forms can be sent to you, if needed, by mail. Register early as space is limited.
